

It's Time For The Annual **COLVILLE, WASHINGTON** **Riding Trip**



OCTOBER 19, 20, 21, 2006

I have reserved 7 cabins for this years trip. The cabins all have two beds but room for cots and I am hoping we fill them out with 3-4 per cabin.

THE RIDING

Those who have been and are returning will vouch, this is dirt bike heaven for those who enjoy flowing single track. There are approx 160 km's of designated trails within this riding park. Great flow, great on the pegs riding, super scenery and great vistas from various peaks. License plate is not required but can be advantageous for extra rides.

THE CABINS

Comfortable with wood burning stoves, propane fridge, hot plates, two twin beds, room for cots but best of all the trails start from the cabins, gas station, bar with pool tables, and store next door - I mean right next door.

THE PLAN

Arrive sometime Thursday evening and take in the welcome reception. Big breakfast and then long day of riding Friday, back for a break and ride again. Big dinner and then seminar by Frank on "Close Talking Without Spraying Spit On The Guy You Are Talking To". Big night of group snoring, followed by big breakfast and then huge day of riding. Big meal, seminar by Frank's brother Rick on "Why I Can't Keep Up Anymore". Slow pack up Sunday morning, breakfast on the road - home sometime Sunday.

THE COST

Based on getting 16 riders, the cost of food and accommodation is approx \$100/person for the 3 nights. Food is prepared by Iron Chef Frank "You Will Be Full" Braeuer. Car pooling is the way to go. If you decide to come for less days the cost is the same as I have prepaid cabins.

THE MISSION

Aside from having a great time with a bunch of like minded riding type guys - one of the big goals is to introduce riders to what our own riding area could look like with effort.
